



"What materials do I submit?"

Submit 20-25 minutes' worth of material. Include book and lyrics, as well as the score and a CD which includes the songs included in your 20-25 minutes' worth. The CD does NOT have to include a singer, if you can crank up the vocal line on your computer so that it's prominent. (We might sing along a little to get the lyrics into the room.) You're certainly welcome to include a singer on your CD, but don't go to expense or trouble making a fancy demo -- we'll be listening to the writing, not the performance. You can upload all this material, or mail it, whichever is most convenient to you.

"How much material should I submit?"

We'll spend almost an hour with your material, so if you submit 15 minutes' worth of material, after we've read it out loud, we'll give you 40 minutes' worth of feedback. If you submit 30 minutes minutes, you'll get 25 minutes of feedback. Although ANMT staff are really fine actors and sight-singers, the point is our feedback rather than our cold-reading performance -- so we urge you to send less material so that you get more feedback. About 20 minutes of material is probably ideal.
